### STUDENT EXPECTATIONS:

**MATERIALS:** Teacher will hand out photocopies from Essential Words for the TOEIC (4<sup>th</sup> Edition) as well as TOEIC (8<sup>th</sup> edition) as needed.

### COURSE COMPONENTS:

- Textbook: Daily use of Essential Words for the TOEIC to practice and become familiar with the components of the TOEIC:
  - Listening: Photo, Question/Response, Conversation, Talks
  - Reading: Incomplete Sentences, Text Completion, Reading Comprehension
- Practice Test: Weekly test to mimic the conditions of a real TOEIC Test.

### LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

- Recognize suffixes that change words into nouns, verbs, adjectives, and adverbs
- Interpret authentic reading materials on common topics and interpret the meaning of reading on specialized topics
- Understand main ideas of descriptive and factual material in spoken English
- Catch on to keywords in a spoken passage in order to answer questions accurately

### STUDENT ASSESSMENTS:

- Tests to mimic the conditions of a real TOEIC Test will be given every Friday.
- Student Evaluation will be given by the Teacher at least once during course. Students who sign up for more than 3 weeks will get an evaluation after every 3 weeks.
